How Did We Get Here?

- Currently, Ambulance Services would get called to a scene, transport the patient to the Hospital ER...
- And the Patient would be then transported to an appropriate Behavioral Health Facility...
- These 2 trips for any NON-INSURED or NON-COVERED Patient would NOT be reimbursed
- The system is flawed and needs to change, the motto RIGHT PLACE, FIRST TIME was created

Department of Mental Health

 The Department of Mental Health was able to receive \$5 million from the Missouri General Revenue fund, for a program that reimburses Ambulance Services for transports of NON-INSURED and NON-COVERED behavioral health patients.

 Department of Mental Health has contracted with MoEMSAC to distribute these funds.

 Up until very recently, Ambulance Services were not paid for transporting to destinations that were NOT hospitals.

New Beginnings and Changes

 March 11, 2024, Emergency Regulation; 19 CSR 30-40.810 went into effect

• This regulation allows an Ambulance Crew with prior written protocols, medical direction, and training all of which are able to provide a thorough evaluation and ability to care for patients with mental health concerns to determine if the patient's care is more appropriately handled at a BHCC and not a Hospital ER

• This training may include the MO Crisis Intervention Team (CIT) training, and is held to be the standard of measure in the field

Let's Get Paid For These Trips

- Now MoEMSAC is going to be responsible for processing payment for qualified transports under the following rules:
- Who is covered under the program?
 - NON-INSURED: Verified patient has no coverage through Medicare, Medicaid, Private Health Insurance, Worker's Compensation, etc.
 - NON-COVERED: Patient is covered by Medicare, Medicaid, or other insurance. AND service is denied as not a covered service by Medicare, Medicaid, or other insurance.

Let's Get Paid For These Trips

Types of trips covered by this program:

- On Scene behavioral health evaluation and referrals with safety plans
- Transport to and from a BHCC or other appropriate outpatient behavioral health/substance abuse treatment centers.
- Scene to direct inpatient stay at a standalone psychiatric facility following EMS Field clearance and mental health evaluation.

Let's Get Paid For These Trips

Types of trips covered by this program:

- Scene directly to facility with inpatient psychiatric services, and ER, to include medical clearance in ER
- 96-Hour hold or behavioral health protective custody transports to an appropriate facility by licensed ambulance service – Upon the execution by appropriately credentialed EMS, law enforcement, health care and/or judicial personnel;
- . ER to In-Patient behavioral health facility for admission with a primary behavioral health, or psychiatric diagnosis

Submitting the Claim

 Processing claims starting with DOS July 1, 2023, until funds are depleted

 MoEMSAC will receive files via HIPAA secure file transfer through FileShare

Each Ambulance Service submitting will have their own secure client account

Clean claims submitted by 15th of the month will be paid same month!
